





One Spring day Jesus rode a donkey into Jerusalem for the festival of Passover.




The people waved their palms and shouted, "Hosanna! Hosanna!"




Jesus ate supper with his disciples. Then they left to the garden where Jesus went off to pray.









The women gasped in surprise when they found the stone door was rolled back.



Jesus is crucified






Jesus is puried
