## Pastoral Ponderings

Relationships: God, Personal and Facebook

While flipping through a waiting room magazine the other day my eyes landed on an interesting little piece. The author was talking about "Mind Myths." According to this author we, humans have the mistaken idea that we have a mental Rolodex with all the names and faces of everyone we've ever know. In truth, the author says: "We can maintain relationships with only about 150 people at once." He goes on to say that we can only put forth the energy to maintain relationships with no more than 150 persons at a time and most of us do not even reach that number.

We all have various ways of being in relationship with one another. There are numerous inperson ways, there is the telephone, and there are numerous electronic means, including Facebook. How do you maintain relationships with those who are important to you? Since it takes energy to maintain relationships, how much of your energy goes into being in relationship with others?

With all of the necessary and important activities that fill our calendars, with all the energy we invest in maintaining our human relationships it is often difficult to find time for God. How do you maintain your relationship with God? Prayer is the primary way we form and maintain our relationship with God. We know that when we have difficulty finding time for prayer, we are not tending to our relationship with God, the One who gives life.

Christians over the past two thousand years have shared multiple ways of praying, communicating with God. There are meditative ways as well as active ways of praying and being aware of the presence of God in all that we do. While some of these ways of praying may at first seem to different from what we've always thought was prayer, they can be effective for some persons.

These Sundays are a transition time of following Jesus in Galilee amid the admiring crowds and following Jesus to Jerusalem during Lent, which begins on February 23<sup>rd</sup>. As we read February's scriptures we continue to gain knowledge of how the Gospel according to Mark understands discipleship living as the way to live out our baptisms and response to Jesus' call to follow. These are the early lessons Jesus teaches his newly called disciples. Lent begins with Ash Wednesday, February 22<sup>nd</sup>. Our journey to Jerusalem begins with Jesus' wilderness temptations.

#### **Ash Wednesday Service Planned**

The Season of Lent will begin on Ash Wednesday, February 22<sup>nd</sup>. This is the traditional start of Lent. The historic focus of this day is to remind us of the pervasiveness of human sin and of the inevitability of human death. Ashes, the traditional sign of grief and mourning, have been adopted by Christians as a sign of our own sinful mortality.

Our service on Ash Wednesday will remind us of our sinful mortality and the grace God offers in forgiveness and acceptance. In keeping with the mood of the day, the service will be quiet and reflective. The Sacrament of Holy Communion is part of the service.

Our individual meditations during the service will be based on these scriptures: Isaiah 58:1-9a, Psalm 51, and Matthew 6:1-6, 16-21.

Please join us on Ash Wednesday for worship. The service will begin at 7:00 PM.

#### **Lenten Study Planned**

Join us for a Lenten Study on Prayer this year. During the Sundays of Lent we will be studying many ways we can pray during our often busy lives. Guiding our work will be the book <u>Praying in the Messiness of Life</u> by Linda Douty. During the study we will consider seven ways to renew our relationships with God. The author writes "It is about developing a friendship with a Friend who won't abandon us no matter how badly we mess up.... Prayer is really more about relationship than results."

The study will begin on Sunday, February 26<sup>th</sup> and conclude on Sunday, April 1<sup>st</sup>. We will meet following worship, after everyone has had a chance to get a cup of coffee. Each session will last approximately an hour and a half.

Please let Rev. Jane know that you will participate so she is certain to have enough study books for everyone. Participants will be asked to contribute toward the cost of the book. Scholarships are available for those who are unable to contribute toward the cost.


